HIGHLIGHTS

- ◇ Didactic Program in Dietetics (DPD) and Dietetic Internship (DI) are accredited by the Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics (ACEND) of The Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics (AND).
- ◇ Dietetics graduates qualify for application to ACEND accredited dietetic internships to become Registered Dietitians.
- ◇ The NuFS/SJSU Dietetic Internship is open only to students with a Nutritional Science degree from SJSU (BS or MS) and other course and grade requirements.
- ◇ Every March, the department co-sponsors a National Nutrition Month event with the SJSU Student Wellness Center as well as Eating Disorders Awareness Week.
- ◇ The department hosts Westpak Expo every year on campus as an opportunity for students to meet and network with industry partners.
