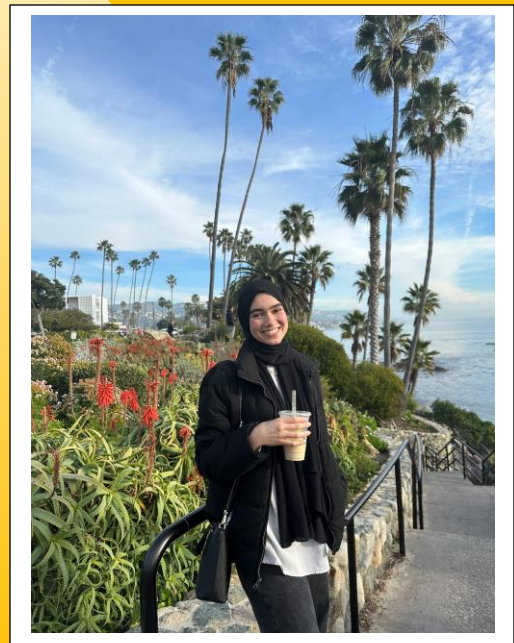
Ms. Deema Saddik
