ME Endowment Scholarship is for ME seniors, juniors or graduate students who have demonstrated their excellence in education.

David Brown Fellowship in Mechatronics is for juniors, seniors or graduate students to promote their professional development in the area of Mechatronics, and also to advance the development of the Mechatronics program at SJSU. Applicants should have taken ME106 or ME285, or an equivalent course elsewhere before Spring 25. Recipients will be encouraged to apply for the TA positions for ME106 during the 25-26 academic year.

Mark A. Pasquale Scholarship is awarded to undergraduate and graduate students majoring in ME.

Robert Dees Memorial Scholarship is awarded to undergraduate or graduate ME students.

Francis Huang Memorial Scholarship is awarded to juniors, seniors, or graduate students majoring in ME.

Mechanical Engineering Veterans Scholarship is awarded to veterans majoring in ME (undergraduate or graduate students).

Note 1: The amount of scholarship awards will vary between \$250 to \$1000 based on funds available and will be disbursed in the beginning of Fall 25.

Note 2: You must be a student at SJSU in Fall 25 to be eligible to receive the award.

Note 3: All awardees are required to attend the ME scholarship award ceremony on Friday, May 9, beginning at 17:30. Scholarship donors will be invited to this event as well as ME alumni.
