Dante's *Divine Comedy* isn't just a masterpiece in the history of literature; it's also a philosophically rich exploration of human nature and the deepest questions of existence. This philosophy seminar will follow Dante's pilgrim through Hell, Purgatory, and Paradise in an exploration of ideas about free will, divine justice, human desire, and the intricate relationship between politics, religion, and ethics.

Alongside traditional research papers, there will also be opportunities to engage in creative projects that capture the poet's legendary wit and sardonic commentary on human failings (e.g., creating maps of our own philosophical journeys modeled on Dante's allegory; developing a Dante insult generator web app; etc.). In other words, this course will involve an intellectual journey that will challenge how you think about morality, human potential, and the complex landscapes of human experience. Are you ready to descend into Hell, climb the mountain of transformation, and ascend toward celestial wisdom?
