- \* **Students who apply to the intern pathway during the program for both phases of student teaching.**
- The intern credential requires that you are enrolled in a supervision course. This may mean repeating 143A or 143B
- **MAT Degree:** The courses in yellow are the ten 3-unit courses which make up the Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT)
- **Tuition:** Part-time = 6 units or less (generally 2 classes); Full-time = > 6 units (generally 3 classes or more) [Tuition & Fee Information](#)
- **Units:** All courses are 3 units with the exception of student teaching (Phase 1 – 4 units; Phase 2—10 units)
- *The Teacher Education Department determines the program plan and course sequence. Note that some courses must be taken concurrently with student teaching; the MAT courses should be taken sequentially.*
